

UMS ANNOUNCES WINTER 2015 COMMUNITY WORKSHOP SERIES ON DANCE

UMS NIGHT SCHOOL AND YOU CAN DANCE MOVEMENT WORKSHOPS TO UNLOCK THE MYSTERY OF DANCE FOR CURIOUS COMMUNITY MEMBERS

ANN ARBOR, MI (December 8, 2015) —The University Musical Society (UMS) announces two free community workshop series in winter 2015 for dance enthusiasts and those curious about the genre. UMS Night School: Curious About Dance runs every Monday from February 2 — March 16 (no class on Monday, March 2) and You Can Dance Workshops with visiting Dance Company Artists coincides with select UMS performances starting Saturday, January 24, 2015. Full details, including session dates and individual session topics start on page 2 of this release.

A 136-year-old multi-disciplinary non-profit performing arts presenter housed on the U-M campus, UMS is in the midst of its 24th year presenting a dance series as part of its overall performance season. According to Jim Leija, Director of Education and Community Engagement at UMS, the genre of dance is still intimidating to many people. "There are any number of physical gestures that people make in their everyday lives to indicate a feeling, an emotion, or an idea through movement; we give a thumbs up when we're pleased, we hang our heads low when we feel sad. But the moment that movement is incorporated into choreography and called 'dance,' many doubt their ability to understand, challenge, or enjoy the experience. The UMS Night School and You Can Dance programs are great ways for dance enthusiasts and the dance curious alike to feel comfortable talking about dance as a genre. Most

importantly, UMS Night School and You Can Dance connect participants to the artists that UMS

presents and to others in the community," said Leija.

UMS NIGHT SCHOOL

Now in its fourth season, UMS Night School is a six-session "mini-course" offered by UMS and taught

by U-M professors and other guests. Starting February 2, UMS Night School will be held Mondays at 7

pm in the U-M Alumni Center (200 Fletcher St.). Hosted by Clare Croft, assistant professor of dance at

the University of Michigan, this winter's UMS Night School will feature 90-minute classes that combine

conversation, lecture, and interactive exercises focused on dance. UMS Night School is free and no pre-

registration is required; interested participants may attend just one session or attend them all.
