Aanii or **Boozhoo**: Hello

Aanikobidoon: Running out of

thread and tying another
piece of thread to the end

Aanikoobidoowaad: Extend by

tying together

Aanikoobijiganag: The

ancestors

Ajjaak: Crane

Aki: Earth

Anishinaabemowin: The way

the Anishinaabe people
speak

Chitwaadewege: Honor Beat,
which is a type of drum beat

Gashkibijigeg: Make bundles

Gawaandag: White spruce

Gijigijigaaneshiinh: Chickadee

Indinawemaaganidog: All of
my relatives

Nindoodem: My clan

Manidoo: Spirit or god

Nindaa: to live currently

Nindoonjibaa: to be originally
from

Noondaagozid: Makes a sound

Wiingashk: Sweet grass
